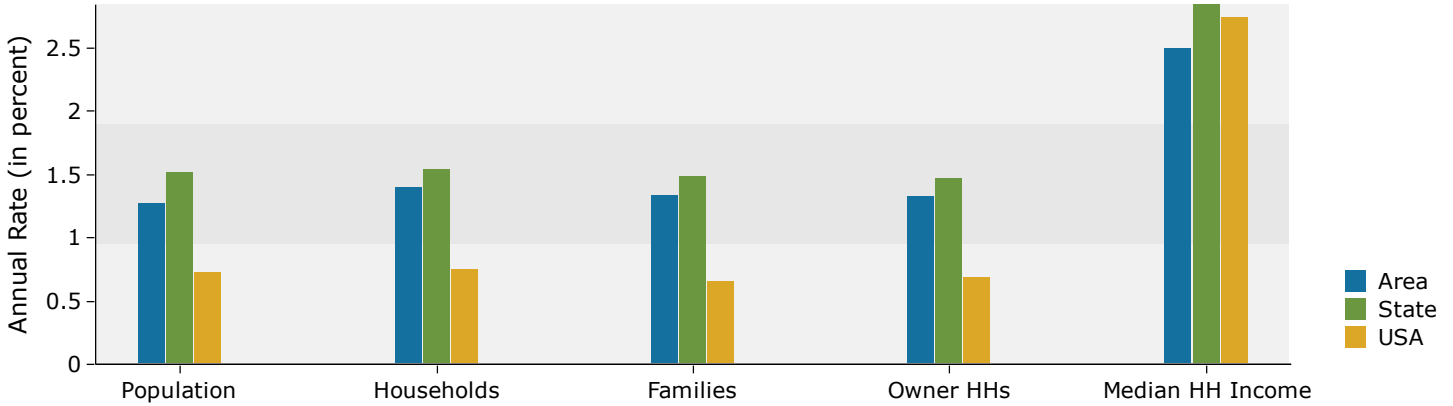

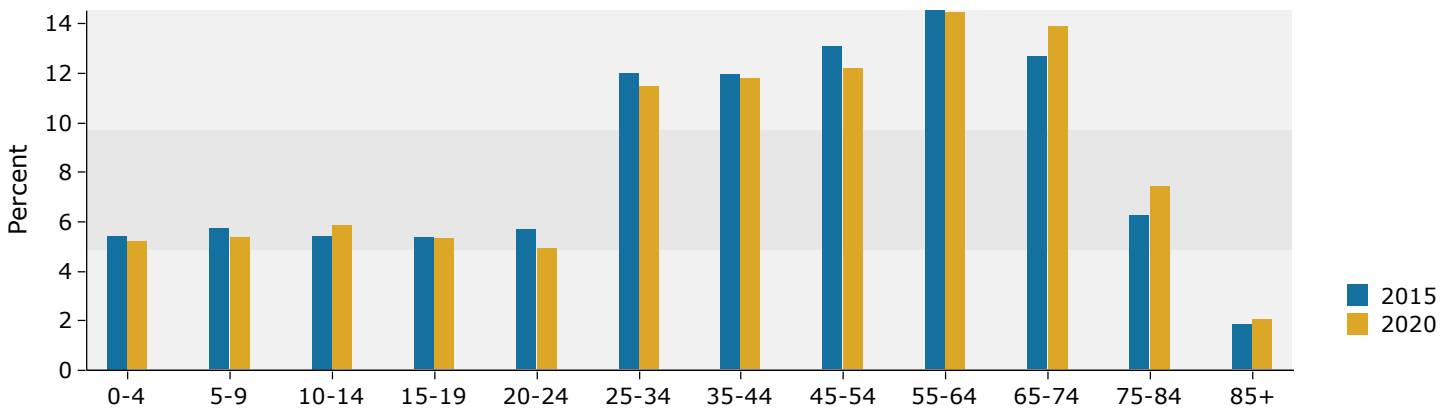

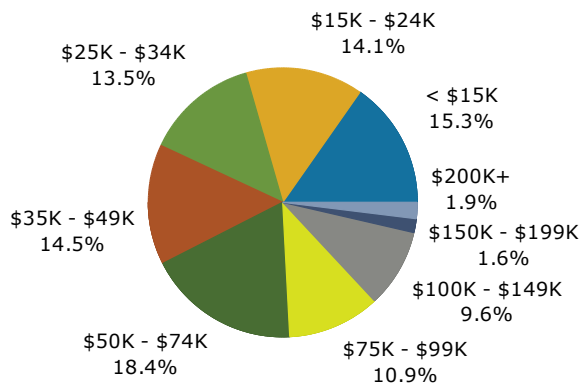

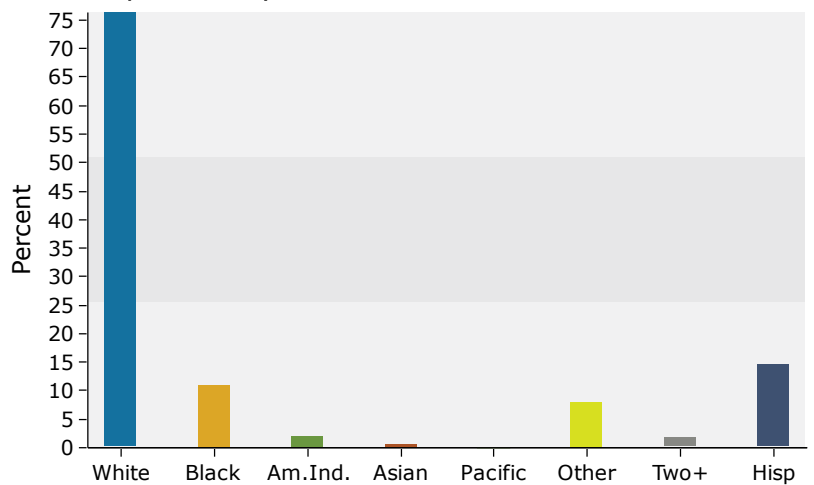
## Population by Age
